in the world. Pass through Sea Point and Camps Bay with its glorious views of the Twelve Apostles. Continue to the fishing village of Hout Bay. Optional short boat trip to Duiker Island (for own account and time permitting) to view the Cape Fur Seals. Travel via Chapman's Peak (if open) to the Cape Point Nature Reserve. See a variety of wildlife that includes baboons, Cape Town by way of Simon's Town, where we visit the penguin colony at Boulder's Beach (for own account) and Fish Hoek fishing village. Before our return, we'll stop for afternoon tea & cake and a visit to Rhodes Memorial, situated on the slopes of Table Mountain offering spectacular views across the city.





Start with a visit to **Paarl** where you will be struck by the beauty of the Valley. Enjoy a **wine tasting and cellar tour** at one of the estates. Continue to **Franschhoek**, founded in 1688 by French immigrants fleeing the Huguenot religious persecution in Europe. A memorial in the town commemorates the arrival of these settlers who helped develop the wines sought after by Napoleon, Bismark and royalty. Stop for lunch (for own account) and another **wine tasting** at a vineyard. Head to **Stellenbosch**, the second oldest town in South Africa. In 1679 Dutch East India Company governor, Simon van der Stel, recognized the fertility of this valley as perfect for vineyards. A blend of 18th century Cape Dutch, Georgian and Victorian buildings is evident on Dorp Street. Enjoy a final **wine tasting** before returning to Cape Town.









Departing from Cape Town city centre, we stop in the **Bo Kaap** for a walk between the brightly coloured homes. Passing some of Cape Town's landmarks, a short drive brings us to **District 6** where we drive through the now decaying ruins of what once was a flourishing mixed race communit but was demolished only to be reserved exclusively for white people. The tour continues to **Langa**, the oldest Black African Township in Cape Town Here we'll have a photo stop at the site that commemorates the student uprising of 1976, as well as visit one of the local churches (Sundays only).

CAPE TOWN FOOD MARKETS

Experience a typical Market Day at the **Oranjezicht City Farm Market**, where small local farmers and artisanal food producers link urban farming with Cape Town's history & heritage, using seasonal produce. Mingle with locals whilst they do their weekly food shopping (vegetables, fruit, bread, honey) and try out some delicious cooked and raw foods (for own account). Continue to the **Neighbour good's Market** at the Old Biscuit Mill. Enjoy delicious eats & treats (for own account) and the opportunity to browse through local fashions, arts, and crafts.

After a morning departure we head up the N1 highway, through the spectacular Hex River Valley and arrive at the Aquila Private Game Reserve. The bio-diverse habitat of the reserve ensures plenty of interest for the avid game viewer and birder. Giraffe, blesbok, black and blue wildebeest, zebra, springbok, gemsbok, klipspringers, duiker, greybuck, steenbok, ostriches, baboons, caracul, foxes, jackal, leopard and 172 species of birds, including the black eagle, are found on the reserve. An experienced game ranger will take you on a game drive. Lunch is enjoyed at the lodge.
