CAPE PENINSULA

FULL DAY

FROM **R 1700**pp

Departs daily except 10; 30 & 31 Mar ± 08h00 | Tour ends ± 17h00 | Excludes lunch, Seal Island boat cruise | Minimum 2 adults

Includes Chapman's Peak Drive (if open), entrance to Cape Point Nature Reserve, Cape of Good Hope, Penguin Colony at Boulders Beach (entrance fee for own account), Tea & Cake and a visit to Rhodes Memorial | Excludes lunch, Seal Island boat cruise

Head for Cape Point and some of the most spectacular views in the world. Pass through Sea Point and Camps Bay with its glorious views of the Twelve Apostles. Continue to the fishing village of Hout Bay. Optional short boat trip to Duiker Island (for own account and time permitting) to view the Cape Fur Seals. Travel via Chapman's Peak (if open) to the Cape Point Nature Reserve. See a variety of wildlife that includes baboons, rhebok, Cape Mountain zebra, bontebok and eland. Return to Cape Town by way of Simon's Town, where we visit the penguin colony at Boulder's Beach (for own account) and Fish Hoek fishing village. Before our return, we'll stop for afternoon tea & cake and a visit to Rhodes Memorial, situated on the slopes of Table Mountain offering spectacular views across the city. We return to Cape Town, passing the University of Cape Town and the Groote Schuur Hospital.



CAPE WINELANDS

FULL DAY

FROM **R 1550**pp

Departs daily except 25 Dec & 01 Jan ± 08h00 | Tour ends ± 17h00 | Excludes lunch | Minimum 2 adults

Includes travelling through historic wine-making towns of Paarl, Franschhoek & Stellenbosch, 3 wine tastings and 1 cellar tour

Start with a visit to Paarl where you will be struck by the beauty of the Valley. Enjoy a wine tasting and cellar tour at one of the estates. Continue to Franschhoek, founded in 1688 by French immigrants fleeing the Huguenot religious persecution in Europe. A memorial in the town commemorates the arrival of these settlers who helped develop the wines sought after by Napoleon, Bismark and royalty. Stop for lunch (for own account) and another wine tasting at a vineyard. Head to Stellenbosch, the second oldest town in South Africa. In 1679 Dutch East India Company governor, Simon van der Stel, recognized the fertility of this valley as perfect for vineyards. A blend of 18th century Cape Dutch, Georgian and Victorian buildings is evident on Dorp Street. Enjoy a final wine tasting before returning to Cape Town.

TABLE MOUNTAIN & CITY

HALF DAY

FROM **R 730**pp

Departs daily (except 24-26, 31 Dec. & 01-02 Jan.) ± 08h00 or ± 13h00 | Tour ends ± 12h30 or ± 17h30 | Excludes cableway ticket fee | Minimum 2 adults

Includes Malay Quarter, Table Mountain (excludes the cost of the Cable Way ticket & weather permitting), drive past the Parliament Buildings, City Hall, Slave Lodge & Company Gardens, visit to the Castle of Good Hope (time permitting), visit to Diamond Cutter | It's recommended that you purchase your Table Mountain cable way tickets on line, prior to the start of the tour.

Drive past the Castle of Good Hope (visit time permitting), City Hall, Grand Parade, St George's Cathedral, Company Gardens and the Malay Quarter. Travel to Kloof Nek and Table Mountain. Ascend to the top (weather permitting) and marvel at the view. On a clear day it is possible to see Robben Island where Nelson Mandela was imprisoned. Tour of Diamond Works.



CAPE HIGHLIGHTS

Scenic drive along the coast, passing through Sea Point and Camps Bay with its views of the Twelve Apostles. Travel to the Cape Point Nature Reserve, comprising over 17,300 acres of indigenous fauna and flora. Following the coastline along False Bay, we'll continue to the Stellenbosch winelands. Stellenbosch is an architectural jewel with a gracious blend of 18th century Cape Dutch, Georgian and Victorian buildings. We then head for a wine tasting session in the Stellenbosch area before returning to Cape Town.

Departing from Cape Town city centre, we stop in the Bo Kaap for a walk between the brightly coloured homes. Passing some of Cape Town's landmarks, a short drive brings us to District 6 where we drive through the now decaying ruins of what once was a flourishing mixed race community, but was demolished only to be reserved exclusively for white people. The tour continues to Langa, the oldest Black African Township in Cape Town. Here we'll have a photo stop at the site that commemorates the student uprising of 1976, as well as visit one of the local churches (Sundays only).



AQUILA WILDLIFE SAFARI

FULL DAY

After a morning departure we head up the N1 highway, through the spectacular Hex River Valley and arrive at the Aquila Private Game Reserve. The bio-diverse habitat of the reserve ensures plenty of interest for the avid game viewer and birder. Giraffe, blesbok, black and blue wildebeest, zebra, springbok, gemsbok, klipspringers, duiker, greyback, steenbok, ostriches, baboons, caracul, foxes, jackal, leopard and 172 species of birds, including the black eagle, are found on the reserve. An experienced game ranger will take you on a game drive. Lunch is enjoyed at the lodge.



CAPE POINT

HALF DAY

FROM **R 1360**pp

Departs daily except 10; 30 & 31 March ± 08h00 | Tour ends ± 12h30 | Minimum 2 adults

Includes Chapman's Peak Drive (if open), entrance to Cape Point Nature Reserve, Penguin Colony at Boulders Beach (entrance fee for own account)

Scenic drive along the Atlantic coast, passing through Sea Point and Camps Bay with its glorious views of the Twelve Apostles. Travel via Chapman's Peak (if open) to the Cape Point Nature Reserve, comprising over 17,300 acres of indigenous fauna and flora. See a variety of wildlife that includes baboons, rhebok, Cape Mountain zebra, bontebok and the elusive eland. The reserve is also one of the world's largest breeding grounds for tortoises. Return to Cape Town by way of Simon's Town (optional, own account & time permitting visit to penguin colony) and Fish Hoek.



CAPE TOWN FOOD MARKETS

HALF DAY

Experience a typical Market Day at the Oranjezicht City Farm Market, where small local farmers and artisanal food producers link urban farming with Cape Town's history & heritage, using seasonal produce. Mingle with locals whilst they do their weekly food shopping (vegetables, fruit, bread, honey) and try out some delicious cooked and raw foods (for own account). Continue to the Neighbour good's Market at the Old Biscuit Mill. Enjoy delicious eats & treats (for own account) and the opportunity to browse through local fashions, arts, and crafts.



HERMANUS

FULL DAY

FROM **R 1550**pp

Departs Wed/Fri/Sun ± 08h30* | Tour ends ± 17h30 | Minimum 2 adults

Hermanus, nestled between mountains and the sea is not only very beautiful but offers some of the best shorebased whale watching opportunities in the world (August - November). Sightings of the Southern Right whale are likely. We continue into the beautiful Hemel en Aarde Valley (Heaven and Earth) to the Bouchard Finlayson Wine Estate. This wine estate is closed on Sundays, but a visit to the Stony Point Penguin Colony will be included instead, to have a look at a unique colony of African penguins (time permitting) before returning to Cape Town in the afternoon.



STELLENBOSCH WINELANDS

HALF DAY

FROM **R 970**pp

Departs Daily (except 25 Dec & 01 Jan) ± 14h00 | Tour ends ± 17h00 | Excludes lunch | Minimum 2 adults

This enchanting excursion begins with a tour through historic Stellenbosch, an architectural jewel that serves as the historic heart of the country's wine region. A gracious blend of 18-century Cape Dutch, Georgian and Victorian buildings is evident as we drive down Dorp Street, where massive Oaks still shade original water furrows, then enjoy a wine tasting in the Stellenbosch area. Return to Cape Town in the late afternoon.
