CAPE PENINSULA

FULL DAY

FROM R 2050_{pp}

Departs daily except 08 Mar, 11 & 12 Apr, 24 May ± 08h00 | Tour ends ± 17h00 | Excludes lunch | Minimum 2 adults

Includes Chapmans Peak Drive (if open), entrance to Cape Point Nature Reserve, Cape of Good Hope, Penguin Colony at Boulders Beach (entrance fee for own account) | Excludes lunch

Head for Cape Point and some of the most spectacular views in the world. Pass through Sea Point and **Camps Bay** with its glorious views of the Twelve Apostles. Travel via **Chapman’s Peak** (if open) to the **Cape Point Nature Reserve**. See a variety of wildlife that includes baboons, rhebok, Cape Mountain zebra, bontebok and eland.

Return to Cape Town by way of **Simon’s Town**, where we visit the **penguin colony at Boulder’s Beach** (for own account) and Fish Hoek fishing village. We return to Cape Town, passing the University of Cape Town and the Groote Schuur Hospital.



CAPE WINELANDS

FULL DAY

FROM R 1930_{pp}

Departs daily except 25 Dec, 01 Jan, 03 Apr, 24 May ± 08h00 | Tour ends ± 17h00 | Excludes lunch | Minimum 2 adults

Includes travelling through historic wine-making towns of Paarl, Franschhoek & Stellenbosch, 3 wine tastings

Start with a visit to **Paarl** where you will be struck by the beauty of the Valley. Enjoy a **wine tasting** at one of the estates. Continue to **Franschhoek**, founded in 1688 by French immigrants fleeing the Huguenot religious persecution in Europe. A memorial in the town commemorates the arrival of these settlers who helped develop the wines sought after by Napoleon, Bismark and royalty. Stop for lunch (for own account) and another **wine tasting** at a vineyard. Head to **Stellenbosch**, the second oldest town in South Africa. In 1679 Dutch East India Company governor, Simon van der Stel, recognized the fertility of this valley as perfect for vineyards. A blend of 18th century Cape Dutch, Georgian and Victorian buildings is evident on Dorp Street. Enjoy a final **wine tasting** before returning to Cape Town.

TABLE MOUNTAIN & CITY

HALF DAY

FROM R 880_{pp}

Departs daily except 24-26, 31 Dec; 01-02 Jan; 24 May ± 08h00 or ± 13h00 | Tour ends ± 12h30 or ± 17h30 | Excludes cableway ticket fee | Minimum 2 adults

Includes Malay Quarter, Table Mountain (excludes the cost of the Cable Way ticket & weather permitting), drive past the Parliament Buildings, City Hall, Slave Lodge & Company Gardens, visit to the Castle of Good Hope (time permitting), visit to Diamond Cutter | It's recommended that you purchase your Table Mountain cable way tickets on line, prior to the start of the tour.

Drive past the **Castle of Good Hope** (visit time permitting), **City Hall**, **Grand Parade**, **St George’s Cathedral**, **Company Gardens** and the **Malay Quarter**. Travel to Kloof Nek and **Table Mountain**. Ascend to the top (weather permitting) and marvel at the view. On a clear day it is possible to see Robben Island where Nelson Mandela was imprisoned. **Tour of Diamond Works**.

CAPE HIGHLIGHTS

FULL DAY

FROM R 2350_{pp}

Departs daily 24-26, 31 Dec; 01-02 Jan, 08 Mar, 03, 11 & 12 Apr, 24 May ± 08h00 | Tour ends ± 17h00 | Excludes lunch | Minimum 2 adults

Includes Table Mountain (excludes the cost of the Cable Way ticket & weather permitting), entrance to Cape Point Nature Reserve, Boulders Beach Penguin Colony (entrance fee for own account), Muizenberg Beach and 1 wine tasting at Groot Constantia Wine Estate | It's recommended that you purchase your Table Mountain cable way tickets on line, prior to the commencement of the tour.

Full Day Cape Highlights Tour with Table Mountain, Cape Peninsula & Constantia Winelands
Meet your local guide, who will show you where to snap the best photos of Cape Town’s most iconic sights. First stop is **Table Mountain**, named one of the 'New 7 Wonders of Nature', for a cable car ride to the top of the mountain (excluding cost of cable way ticket & weather permitting). Travel via the scenic **Chapman’s Peak drive** (if open) to **Cape Point Nature Reserve**, for a picture of the famous Cape Point lighthouse dating back to 1859. Visit **Boulders Beach** (entrance fee for own account), home to a colony of African Penguins and then to **Muizenberg Beach**, one of the most popular Cape Town beaches, dotted with colourful beach huts along the sand and locally known as ‘surfers paradise’. Head to **Groot Constantia Wine Estate**, for a wine tasting and wander through the scenic vineyards. Return to Cape Town, passing the University of Cape Town and the Groote Schuur Hospital.

TOWNSHIP

HALF DAY

FROM R 1135_{pp}

Departs Tue, Thurs, Sat & Sun morning (except 16, 25-26 Dec. & 01-02 Jan)) ± 09h00 | Tour ends ±12h30 | Minimum 2 adults

Includes Malay Quarter (Bo Kaap), District Six, Langa Township, a visit to a church service in Langa (on the Sunday morning tour)

Departing from Cape Town city centre, we stop in the **Bo Kaap** for a walk between the brightly coloured homes. Passing some of Cape Town’s landmarks, a short drive brings us to **District 6** where we drive through the now decaying ruins of what once was a flourishing mixed race community, but was demolished only to be reserved exclusively for white people. The tour continues to **Langa**, the oldest Black African Township in Cape Town. Here we’ll have a photo stop at the site that commemorates the student uprising of 1976, as well as visit one of the local churches (Sundays only).

WILDLIFE SAFARI

FULL DAY

FROM R 3795_{pp}

Departs daily 09h00-10h00 | Tour ends ±19h30 | Includes lunch | Minimum 2 adults

After a morning departure we head up the N1 highway, through the spectacular **Hex River Valley** and arrive at the **Aquila Private Game Reserve**. The bio-diverse habitat of the reserve ensures plenty of interest for the avid game viewer and birder. **Giraffe, blesbok, black and blue wildebeest, zebra, springbok, gemsbok, klipspringers, duiker, greybuck, steenbok, ostriches, baboons, caracul, foxes, jackal, leopard** and 172 species of birds, including the black eagle, are found on the reserve. An experienced game ranger will take you on a game drive. Lunch is enjoyed at the lodge.

CAPE POINT

HALF DAY

FROM R 1650_{pp}

Departs daily except 08 Mar, 11 & 12 Apr, 24 May ± 08h00 | Tour ends ± 12h30 | Minimum 2 adults

Includes Chapmans Peak Drive (if open), entrance to Cape Point Nature Reserve, Penguin Colony at Boulders Beach (entrance fee for own account)

Scenic drive along the Atlantic coast, passing through Sea Point and **Camps Bay** with its glorious views of the Twelve Apostles. Travel via **Chapman’s Peak** (if open) to the **Cape Point Nature Reserve**, comprising over 17,300 acres of indigenous fauna and flora. See a variety of wildlife that includes baboons, rhebok, Cape Mountain zebra, bontebok and the elusive eland. The reserve is also one of the world’s largest breeding grounds for tortoises. Return to Cape Town by way of **Simon’s Town** (optional, own account & time permitting visit to **penguin colony**) and Fish Hoek.

CAPE TOWN ANTI-APARTHEID STRUGGLE

HALF DAY

FROM R 1015_{pp}

Departs Monday - Saturday ± 09h00 | Tour ends ± 12h30 | Minimum 2 adults

Includes light lunch | visit to the Trojan Horse Memorial | visit to the sites where Ashley Kriel and Anton Fransch were killed

Join a morning tour, starting with a drive to Sea Point Promenade, where a pair of giant stainless-steel sunglasses, meant to honour the late president Nelson Mandela, stares out to Robben Island. Then travel with an expert local guide to Bonteheuvel and Athlone on the Cape Flats. Enjoy a famous local delicacy, The Gatsby. Hear more about the Athlone heroes, the 20-year-old anti-apartheid activist, Ashley Kriel and Anton Fransch, who faced a brutal end in the epic ‘Battle of Athlone’. Visit the Trojan Horse Memorial, commemorating the Trojan Horse Massacre, when three young people were killed and several others injured. The tour concludes at the Cape Town City Hall, where Nelson Mandela first addressed the nation as a free man on 11 February 1990, the most striking symbol of the end of apartheid in South Africa.

HERMANUS

FULL DAY

FROM R 1930_{pp}

Departs Wed/Fri/Sun ± 08h30* | Tour ends ± 17h30 | Minimum 2 adults

Hermanus, nestled between mountains and the sea is not only very beautiful but offers some of the best shorebased whale watching opportunities in the world (**August – November**). Sightings of the **Southern Right whale** are likely. We continue into the beautiful **Hemel en Aarde Valley** (Heaven and Earth) to the **Bouchard Finlayson Wine Estate**. This wine estate is closed on Sundays, but a visit to the **Stony Point Penguin Colony** will be included instead, to have a look at a unique colony of African penguins (time permitting) before returning to Cape Town in the afternoon.

STELLENBOSCH WINELANDS

HALF DAY

FROM R 1155_{pp}

Departs Daily (except 25 Dec. & 01 Jan, 03 Apr; 24 May) ± 14h00 | Tour ends ± 17h00 | Excludes lunch | Minimum 2 adults

This enchanting excursion begins with a tour through historic Stellenbosch, an architectural jewel that serves as the historic heart of the country’s wine region. A gracious blend of 18-century Cape Dutch, Georgian and Victorian buildings is evident as we drive down Dorp Street, where massive Oaks still shade original water furrows, then enjoy a wine tasting in the Stellenbosch area. Return to Cape Town in the late afternoon.
